Take the following 14-day treatment

Proton-pump inhibitors Options: Losec (Omeprazole) 20mg Prevacid (Lansoprazole) 30mg Pantoloc (Pantoprazole) 40mg Pariet (Rabeprazole) 20mg Nexium (Esomeprazole) 40mg Dexilant (Dexlansoprazole) 60 or 90mg	1 tablet 2x/day	Strong blocker of acid production in the stomach.	NauseaHeadacheDry mouthLoose stools
Bismuth subsalicylate (Pepto-Bismol)	2 tablets 4x/day	Commonly used to treat indigestion.	 Dark-colored stool Black tongue Dizziness & confusion (rare) * Patients with kidney problems should consult their physician before taking Pepto-Bismol due to potential nervous system side effects.
Met ronidazole	500 mg 3x/day	Antibiotic commonly used to treat diarrhea due to infections.	 Nausea Metallic taste in the mouth Loose stools *You are not allowed to drink any alcoholic drinks while taking this medication as it gives an alcohol-like reaction.
T etracycline	500 mg 4x/day	Antibiotic commonly used to treat several kinds of infections including pneumonia and skin infections.	 Nausea and vomiting Loose stools Skin rash * Exposure to sunlight should be avoided as patients sometimes become more sensitive to sunburn while taking this medication. Side effects occur in less than 5% of patients.

Importance of adherence for treatment success

Despite the fact that side effects are listed most people can take these medications without too much difficulty. However, we know that that success of treatments is lower if not all tablets are taken. Therefore, it is important that you try to take all medication as prescribed.
